In partnership with SOLACE (Society of Local Authority Chief Executives), ADEPT's inspirational leadership programme is designed specifically to explore the demanding place director role and its challenges in an increasingly complex and uncertain environment.

The programme has been created for aspiring place directors who have reached Tier 3 senior leadership level. Working with a network of colleagues with similar ambitions, the programme will give participants the opportunity to:

- Develop new skills
- Debate issues
- Hear from current Place Directors
- Build on previous leadership and management training
- Explore challenges

The programme will launch on the 7th February 2020, with a one-day session that will provide an overview of the aims, concepts and modules in more detail and an opportunity to network with colleagues. The launch is followed by four modules running from March to September 2020. The two-day workshops will cover:

Leadership and Change

• Exploring the role of leadership in delivering change

Strategic Thinking

• Thinking about the future and generating insights and opportunities

Working Collaboratively

• How to establish a common purpose, a strong insistence on a whole systems approach and shared power to stimulate change

Coaching for High Performance

• A coaching style of managing

• A facilitated group approach to learning and real problem solving skills based on enquiry and insight, rather than advice

We are seeking applications from a wide range of people and backgrounds. We are committed to delivering on our 50/50 initiative to encourage diversity and bring different perspectives to both the programme and ADEPT.

The entire programme costs $f_{1,750}$ * and we hope aspiring place directors will take advantage of a programme designed specifically for them.
